

## UC Merced Data Request Decision Chart: Supplemental Information

## Definitions and Reporting Guidelines

- Definitions:
  - Historical/census data is static/frozen data that was captured on a particular census date or survey administration period and serves as an unchanging, historical record as of that date. It is used for official campus reporting. Examples: student and faculty/staff data on the IRDS website; campus Data Warehouse.
  - Current/transactional data is dynamic/changing data that is frequently updated by functional offices. It is used for day-to-day operations. Examples: Student Information System (Banner); Operational Data Store (ODS); Payroll/Personnel System.
- Reporting Guidelines:
  - Ensure compliance with <u>FERPA</u> and UC Merced data standards.
  - Aggregated data with fewer than 5 members per entry should only be reported if a "reasonable person" could not identify an individual and obtain protected information (policy).
